#### A Message From Pastor Woods

Dear Friends,

In his book, *Life Together*, Dietrich Bonhoeffer speaks of the importance of setting aside time each day for reading God's Word and praying. Through prayer each and every one of us speaks to God and in His Word God speaks to each and every one of us. This two-way communication keeps us "in the loop" with the Father and the Holy Spirit and draws us all three of us closer together. The Holy Spirit breathes His life into us and strengthens us for meeting the responsibilities of the day, and God promises to love us and care for us.

On one occasion Luther wrote in his diary, "I have so much to do tomorrow I'll have to spend an extra hour in prayer." He had no problem believing that prayer can move mountains. He had seen how God had opened the hearts of millions of people throughout Europe to the Gospel in spite of opposition from the Church of Rome and the Holy Roman Emperor—and he attributed it all to God's Word and to prayer. With that kind of power at our disposal, why would we rely on our own strength?

The usual reason has to do with time—our busy schedules and our need to "get on with the day." Who has time for prayer? We are like a man lumbering up a hill with 100 pounds on his back who refuses a ride offered to him because he doesn't have time to take the load off his back and get in the car.

There's an old saying to the effect that he who does not pray in a specific time and a specific place every day probably doesn't pray at all. So make out a new schedule for yourself: set aside 15 minutes each morning for Word and prayer. I promise you that you will be glad you did.

Join us for a fascinating lecture on Michelangelo and his religious art.





Fun Sunday School Activities:






Sunday School in February meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays during worship.

#### **EASTER ILLUSTRATION MINISTRY**



If you can color, we need you!

During the season of Lent, Hope's members are invited to be a part of a congregation wide illustration that will be on display for Easter.

Thirty six (36) individual parts of a larger picture need to be colored so they can be assembled for Easter. The simple directions and coloring supplies will be available in a basket on the welcome table. All colored pictures need to be returned to the basket by March 17<sup>th</sup>.

On Ash Wednesday, as Lent begins, worshipers' foreheads are often marked with ashes in the sign of the cross. The ashes traditionally come from burning palm branches from the previous Palm Sunday. In the Old Testament, ashes were a sign of mourning and repentance. Today, some worshipers wipe off the ashes before leaving church, to symbolize being cleansed from sin by Jesus' death; others wear the ashes the rest of the day, carrying the cross of Christ into the world. Reciting Genesis 3:19 often accompanies the placement of ashes: "You are dust, and to dust you shall return."
