A Message From Pastor Woods

Dear Friends,

The Apostle John begins his Gospel with the following verse: "In the beginning was the word and the word was with God and the word was God." In this verse "the word" refers to two things. One is the words God spoke to create the universe: "Let there be light, sun, moon etc." The other is God's word made flesh and blood—Jesus Christ—Who came to save mankind. In either case it is correct to say that God created and redeemed mankind through the power of His Word.

Martin Luther once said that the word of God was only authority the church had and that any church which compromised or abandoned the word in its teaching and preaching was not a Christian church. Tragically, we have come to a time in America when mainline Christian denominations have abandoned or compromised God's word in their teaching and peaching. In an effort to become more "relevant" or "culture-friendly" they describe their anti-Biblical doctrines as "progressive" and Biblical doctrines as "outdated" and "irrelevant."

But God will not be mocked and He has drawn large numbers of members of these churches away and led them to churches where God's word is preached and taught. Huge numbers of members of mainline denominations are leaving their churches and joining independent evangelical churches like Parkside, Christ Community Church, Crossways Churches where the teachings of the Bible are honored.

I thank God that Hope Lutheran Church is part of a synod—the Missouri Synod"—where the Word of God is also the word of the church.


